SECTION 4 — FIRST AID MEASURES

Contact with acid liberates toxic and flammable hydrogen sulfide gas.

When heated to decomposition, may emit toxic fumes.

In case of fire: Use a tri-class dry chemical fire extinguisher.

Remove all sources of water and acids. Sweep up, place in sealed bag or container and dispose. Ventilate area and wash spill site after material pickup is complete. See Sections 8 and 13 for further information.

SECTION 7 — HANDLING AND STORAGE

Flinn Suggested Chemical Storage Pattern: Inorganic #5. Store with sulfides, phosphides, carbides and nitrides. Store in a cool, dry place. Air and moisture sensitive. Store in a Flinn Chem-SafTM bag. Use fume hood when heating.

Wear protective gloves, protective clothing, and eye protection. Wash hands thoroughly after handling.
